The Paul Pandos Bursary of \$1,000 will be offered annually to a student enrolling in an accredited post-secondary or post-graduate music program. Preference will be given to students residing in Prince Edward County, the Bay of Quinte Region and the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory.

Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident.

This form must be completed in its entirety and submitted with the required supporting materials. Please follow the guidelines located in the *Application Requirements* section of this document. **The deadline for applications is May 31st each year.**

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application Process

1. Complete the Paul Pandos Bursary Application form (this document). You can either enter information directly in the form fields or print and fill the form by hand.
2. Gather supporting materials.
3. Email the completed form and supporting materials to bursary@pecjazz.org.

Supporting Materials

Applications should include the following supporting materials:

1. The completed Paul Pandos Bursary Application form (this document).
2. A personal essay or video describing the reason for pursuing studies in music, a description of the program you plan to take, and the areas in which you plan to specialize.
3. A copy of your resume.
4. A letter of reference from a teacher, professor, or professional from the music community.
5. Proof of confirmation of acceptance into the accredited post-secondary music program.

ASSESSMENT

The PEC Jazz Festival follows the process below for accepting and evaluating applications, and awarding a bursary:

- Each applicant will receive an acknowledgement of receipt of submitted application.
- Each submitted application will be evaluated by the PEC Jazz Festival adjudication panel.
- The successful candidate will be notified by email and the awarded bursary will be sent by post or delivered in-person as soon as possible.
- The successful applicant's name may be shared through press releases or other publicity methods.
